TEAM: You must specify which four dogs go with which Team, since owners are not required in the rules to be identical. If possible, please submit Team Obedience entries together. Either or all dogs may be entered in a class or classes.

Qualifying Scores will be Required for All Prizes In Regular Classes.

A Qualifying Score will not be required to earn Ribbons or Prizes in any Non-Regular Class.

A Dark Green Qualifying Ribbon will be given to each dog attaining a Qualifying Score.

A New Title Rosette will be Awarded to teams (Handler/Dog) earning a New Title.

Obedience & Rally transfers will be allowed for each Obedience/Rally Trial per AKC Regulations. A Refund of all but \$10.00 of the entry fee will be refunded for bitches entered in Obedience/Rally that come in season after the entries close. A Veterinarian's certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary no later than 1/2 hour prior to the start of the 1st class in the trial.
