Attention, Exhibitors

- This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these trials.
- Please clean up after your dog. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial with no refund of entry fees.
- Dogs are allowed in rings during judging only and must be wearing the correct collar. As per AKC Obedience Regulations Chapter 2, Section 17:
- The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Trial Secretary is not able to cash checks.
- No Space is provided for dogs not entered in the trial and only dogs that are AKC eligible are allowed at the trial.
- Exhibitors should follow their Veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
